Study: A Useful Vessel

Text: Colossians 3:18

"PUTTING ON CHRIST IN OUR RELATIONSHIPS—WIVES"

<u>Memory verse</u>: <u>2 Timothy 2:21</u> If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet [*useful*] for the **Master's** use, *and* prepared unto every good work.

<sup>†</sup> The Christian's *PROGRESSION*—to be "AS CHRIST" (v. 10b)

<sup>+</sup> The Christian's *PRACTICE*—to *IMITATE* CHRIST (v. 12b-14)

The challenge for us each day is—to LOOK <u>DISTINCLY</u> LIKE CHRIST!

† The PRACTICE of a USEFUL Vessel—"Putting On" Christ in his \_\_\_\_\_\_(Colossians 3:18-25)

INTRODUCTION: Our goal in this study is to seek to be a "Useful Vessel for the Master."

I. Usefulness In Our \_\_\_\_\_ Life (Colossians 3:18-21)

Q: How can you be the most effective and useful vessel to Christ's work as a wife, husband, child, father, and/ or servant?

## Homes are Biblically built upon authority and submission.

A. The Biblical Role of the \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 18)

**Proverbs 18:22** Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good *thing*, and obtaineth favour of the LORD.

1. Consider God's \_\_\_\_\_ (Ephesians 5:22)

The phrase "*submit yourselves*" carries the idea to be under \_\_\_\_\_; a military term referring to rank.

Biblical submission does not refer to \_\_\_\_\_ but hierarchy.

**Ephesians 5:22** Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the **Lord**.

Wives, consider your submission to your husband as a way in which you \_\_\_\_\_\_ God.

This phrase, "fit in the Lord" can also be translated "as is fitting to those who belong to the Lord" or "as is your right and proper duty in the Lord."

2. Consider God's \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Timothy 2:12-13)

**<u>1Timothy 2:12-13</u>** But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence. **13** For Adam was first formed, then Eve.

<u>Genesis 3:16</u> Unto the woman He said, "I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire *shall be* to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee."

**<u>1</u>** Corinthians **11:3** But I would have you know, that the head of every man is **Christ**; and the head of the woman *is* the man; and the head of **Christ** *is* **God**.

3. Consider the \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Peter 3:1-6)

Consider here what God considers to be "*of great price*"—"*a meek and quiet spirit.*" This attitude of the heart is of great value in the sight of God.

Q: Husbands, are you giving her honor?

God gives grace to those who are "*clothed with* \_\_\_\_\_\_"—those who refuse to demand their own way! (1 Peter 5:5)

4. Consider Christ's \_\_\_\_\_ (John 6:38)

John 6:38 "For I came down from heaven, not to do Mine own will, but the will of Him that sent Me.

Consider Christ being *subject* unto his parents (Luk 2:51).

Q: Wives, are you willingly submitting to your husband's leadership? Remember it is your service to God.

Q: Husbands, are you encouraging your wife to submit by leading her in a loving way?

## What is my next step?

(*Put off*) What must I put off that is both hinder my walk with Christ or someone else's?

(*Renew your mind*) What qualities or Words of Christ must I meditate upon?

(*Put on*) What qualities of Christ must I seek to have as a characteristic of my life?
