**Mission Statement:** to passionately serve GOD and to compassionately serve others—ALL to the glory of GOD!

<u>Memory verse</u>: <u>2 Timothy 2:21</u> If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet [*useful*] for the **Master's** use, *and* prepared unto every good work.

† Usefulness In Our \_\_\_\_\_ Life (Colossians 4:5-6)

The challenge for us is—to LOOK <u>DISTINCLY</u> LIKE CHRIST in our PUBLIC lives!

Q: What does your public life look like? Is it clear to others that Christ is your Master and you are seeking to honor Him in everything?

# I. \_\_\_\_\_ WISELY in your PUBLIC LIFE (v. 5)

This word, "wisdom" can be defined as the \_\_\_\_\_ use of knowledge. "Walking in wisdom" includes being \_\_\_\_\_ in fulfilling your responsibilities; doing your work, paying your bills, and keeping your promises.

**1 Thessalonians 4:12** That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and *that* ye may have lack of nothing.

Cf. 1 Timothy 3:7

"...redeeming the time." -

**Ephesians 5:16** Redeeming [make the most of] the time, because the days are evil.

Cf. Ephesians 5:15-17

<u>James 1:5</u> If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask [keep on asking] of **God**, that giveth to all *men* liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

By "redeeming the time" we seek to make the best use of opportunities. In order for a believer to bridge the gap he must see that every opportunity as one that will help or hinder their usefulness for Christ.

II.	WISELY in you	ur PUBLIC LIFE (	(v. 6)

Q: How do your words sound to others? Are your words *honey* or *vinegar*?

**James Strong** (Exhaustive Concordance) defines "grace" as the divine influence upon the heart and its reflection in the life.

Consider Christ's testimony,

<u>Luke 4:22</u> And all bare **Him** witness, and wondered at the gracious words which proceeded out of **His** mouth. And they said, "Is not this Joseph's son?"

### A. With GRACIOUS \_\_\_\_\_

<u>Proverbs 16:21</u> The wise in heart shall be called prudent: and the sweetness of the lips increaseth learning.

<u>Proverbs 16:24</u> Pleasant words *are as* an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

A truth spoke WITH grace goes so much further than trust spoken WITHOUT grace.

Cf. Proverbs 15:23

<u>Proverbs 15:7</u> The lips of the wise disperse knowledge: but the heart of the foolish *doeth* not so.

**Ephesians 4:29** Let no corrupt [rotten or worthless] communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying [building up], that it may minister grace [spiritual blessings] unto the hearers.

## C. With \_\_\_\_\_ COMMUNICATION

In our public lives we must speak the *stabilizing truths* of God. People need to hear God's Word. In order to speak the Word's of God we must be in the Word of God.
