Paul emphasizes that a detrimental thought process leads to destructive actions.
I to Put OFF
A. PUT OFF Kinds of (v. 5)
One of our greatest challenges in life is that we ourselves too much. This gets us into trouble.
"fornication" – This is any unlawful act.
"uncleanness" – an unholy which comes from a perverted passion of the heart.
"inordinate affection" – This speaks of a kind of desire that is and unreasonable.
"evil concupiscence" – wicked cravings or injurious intentions;
"covetousness" – a constant desire for
B. PUT OFF Kinds of (v. 8-9)
<u>1 Peter 2:1</u> Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings,
"anger" – habitual of abhorrence
"wrath" – sudden of anger
<u>Ecclesiastes 7:9</u> Be not hasty in thy spirit to be angry: for anger resteth the bosom of fools.
"malice" – This is attitude of ill will toward others.

"blasphemy" – Speech that _____ others down.

"filthy communication" - foul speech or dirty humor; obscene language
"lie" is a of the truth in any form to any degree
<u>Colossians 4:6</u> Let your speech <i>be</i> <u>always</u> with grace, seasoned with salt that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.
II to PUT OFF
Proverbs 1:10 My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not.
A. Putting off by
1. Remember that you are to sin (Rom. 6:11)
2. Remember God's (Colossians 3:6-7)
Remember that God hates sin.
B. Putting off by (1 John 1:9)
<u>Luke 12:15</u> And He said unto them, "Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth [is] not [defined by] in the abundance of the things which he possesseth."
