# OUR PURSUIT—THE CHARACTERISTICS

*Mission Statement:* to passionately serve GOD and to compassionately serve others—ALL to the glory of GOD!

<u>Memory verse</u>: <u>2 Timothy 2:21</u> If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet [*useful*] for the **Master's** use, *and* prepared unto every good work.

## + Our Pursuit—To be a USEFUL Vessel (2 Timothy 2:20-23)

- I. The Conditions of a USEFUL Vessel (v. 21)
  - A. God wants a SEPARATED vessel
  - B. God wants an HONORABLE vessel
  - C. God wants a <u>SAVED</u> vessel
  - D. God wants a *PROFITABLE* vessel
  - E. God wants a <u>READY</u> vessel

## II. The Characteristics of a USEFUL Vessel (v. 22-23)

Paul gives Timothy three specific actions to help him become more useful to the Lord. He is to *flee, follow,* and *fellowship*. In each of these areas we must learn to be \_\_\_\_\_\_ in applying them.

In context here, these "*lusts*" refer to \_\_\_\_\_\_ desires that are prominent during our youth.

**<u>1 Timothy 6:11</u>** But thou, O man of **God**, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.

Why should Timothy run from these "youthful lusts?"

1. Because you are \_\_\_\_\_

**<u>2</u>** Corinthians 3:5 "Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think anything as of ourselves;..."

**Romans 7:18** For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will [*the desire*] is present with me; but *how* to perform [*the ability*] that which is good I find not.

## The reality is that God created us as dependent creatures.

In John 15:5, Jesus says, "...for without Me ye can do\_\_\_\_\_."

**Philippians 2:13** For it is **God** which worketh [*energizes/ putting forth His power*] in you both to will [*desire*] and to do [*the power*] of *His* good pleasure [*perfect will*]. (Cf. 2 Corinthians 9:8; Philippian 4:13)

**<u>1 Timothy 6:11</u>** But thou, O man of **God**, flee these things; and follow after [*pursue with a consuming passion*] righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.
