Application:

So what do we take from this message?

1. Let us understand the *importance of the Gospel message* being a message of grace through faith in Christ's completed work. He worked for our salvation so we didn't have to because we can't do anything good enough to earn it.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death [this is what we earn & deserve]; but the GIFT of **God** is eternal life through **Jesus Christ** our **Lord** [this is God's grace].

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall CALL upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

- 2. Let us also be reassured of the *authority* that God had given to Paul—Paul's message was God's message. If we are always questioning the authority of the Bible we will always be questioning the message of the Bible. The Bible is God's Word—He is the Author of it.
- 2 Peter 1:21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.
- **2 Timothy 3:16-17** All scripture *is* given by inspiration of **God**, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of **God** may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.
 - 3. Let us see the *unity of New Testament Scripture*. God spoke ONE message through each of these men to the different groups of people.
