"PAUL'S DEFENCE OF JUST	ΓΙFICATION" (Part 1)

**Key Verse:** Galatians 3:4 Have ye suffered [experienced] so many things in vain? if it be yet in vain.

"Justification" is the <u>act</u> of God whereby the believing sinner is "declared righteous" solely on the merits of Christ's righteousness. It is not only "just as if I had never sinned," but also the fact that God now and forever sees the saint as righteous because as He looks upon the saint, He sees the righteousness of His Son.

Next Paul draws appeals to their experience about the Holy Spirit.

A. How did you the Holy Spirit? (v. 2)

**Romans 8:9** But ye are not in the flesh, but in the **Spirit**, if so be that the **Spirit** of **God** dwell in you. Now if any man have not the **Spirit** of **Christ**, he is none of **His**.

B. Are you \_\_\_\_\_\_ by your efforts? (v. 3)

Colossians 2:6-7 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye

in **Him**: **7** Rooted and built up in **Him**, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.

Cf. Philippians 1:6

<u>Galatians 5:16</u> This I say then, Walk [to be constantly occupied with] in the **Spirit**, and ye shall not fulfil [gratify] the lust of the flesh.

<u>Philippians 2:12b-13</u> ...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. <sup>13</sup> For it is **God** which worketh in you both to will [*desire*] and to do [*the power*] of *His* good pleasure [*perfect will*].
