Paul's toward the Saints (v. 17-20) **2 Timothy 4:2** Preach the Word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove [address an error], rebuke [warn of the consequences], exhort [encourage] with all longsuffering [patience] and doctrine [instruction]. **A.** The \_\_\_\_\_ and their goal (v. 17) Paul clearly exposes the intentions of the Judaizers. He calls for the Galatian saints to consider their intentions. He wants them to see how they do not have their best interests in mind. When Paul first came to Galatia his desire was to win the over to Christ's side while in contrast the Judaizers desired to win them over to their own side. B. The deceived and their \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 18-20) Notice the heart of Paul as he continues his faithful stewardship over these saints. 1. Paul's (v. 18-19) **Proverbs 27:6** Faithful *are* the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy *are* deceitful. "My little children,..." - This is a strong term of endearment. Paul speaks from a sincere heart of love of these, his children in the faith. 2. Paul's (v. 20) Q: What is your attitude when you hear the convicting words of God? How do you respond? Q: Do you read and listen just going through the motions hoping others are listening because they need to be changed? What is my next step? (*Put off*) What must I put off that is both hinder my walk with Christ or someone else's? (Renew your mind) What qualities or Words of Christ must I meditate upon? (*Put on*) What qualities of Christ must I seek to have as a characteristic of my life?
