Study: Galatians	Text: Galatians 5:22-23
"THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT—	-WALKING WITH GOODNESS"

The only way for the believer to have success in the Christian life is by "walking in the Spirit"—being saturated by the Person of Jesus Christ and dominated by the power of the Holy Spirit dwelling in the life of the believer.

The "fruit of the spirit" is a God empowered <u>attitude</u> of the heart that leads to <u>action</u> which characterizes the life—it is GODly attitude that leads to GODly action.

I. The <u>Meaning</u> of Goodness

This word "goodness" speaks of character that is energized, expressing itself in active good—doing right in the midst of wrong.

<u>Micah 6:8</u> He hath shewed thee, O man, what *is* good; and what doth the **LORD** require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy **God**?

II. Christ's of Goodness

<u>Acts 10:38</u> How **God** anointed **Jesus** of Nazareth with the **Holy Ghost** and with power: **Who** went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with **Him**.

A. It is seen in His <u>Works</u> which bring ______(Romans 5:7-11)

Christ's "goodness" was seen in His sacrifice for our salvation. He sacrificed His life for our greatest good and God's glory.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:21</u> For **He** hath made **Him** [*Jesus*] *to be* sin for us, **Who** knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of **God** in **Him**.

B. It is seen in His <u>Words</u> which bring ______(John 8:1-11)

III. Our <u>Manifestation</u> of Goodness

Ephesians 2:10 For we are **His** workmanship [*masterpiece*], created in **Christ Jesus** unto good works, which **God** hath before ordained that we should walk in them.
