# Paul and His Prayers – Part 1 (Philippians 1:3-8)

Last Sunday we introduced Paul's letter to the Church at Philippi.

- I. Paul's <u>Mindset</u> as a <u>Servant</u> (Philippians 1:1)
  - A. He was <u>Submissive</u> in Life to God—"Servants of Jesus Christ" (Php 1:1)

B.He was <u>Satisfied</u> with His Life for God—"I have learned...to be content" (Php 4:10-23)

II. Paul's <u>Message</u> to the <u>Saints</u> (Php 1:1b-2)

A. <u>Who</u> the Letter was <u>for</u>—"the saints in Christ Jesus" (Php 1:1b)
B.<u>What</u> the Letter <u>said</u>—"Grace and Peace" (Php 1:2)

Paul humbled himself to the Father's will and in turn the grace that he desired for the church was abounding in his life. Thus he was satisfied with the life that the Lord called him to live.
