
# A Servant's Heart is Encouraged (Philippians 2:1-4)

Rivalries within any group can be dangerous, especially in a local church body. Pride is the root cause as it prompts people to push for their own way, for their own glory.

**Romans 12:10** *Be* kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another;

Cf. Ephesians 5:21; 1 Peter 5:5

Too often we are so self consumed that the needs of others are not even thought of.

"esteem other" – This is placing more value upon other's needs.
