"The LORD is my Shepherd"

Q: What comes to mind when you hear the phrase, "The LORD is my Shepherd?

This LORD is the Eternal, self-existent God who has always existed. He is the God who sustains Himself.

<u>Deuteronomy 31:8</u> And the LORD, He <u>it is</u> that doth go before thee; He <u>will</u> be with thee, He <u>will</u> not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed.

The "LORD," He is the **God of peace** (Isaiah 26:3); He is the **God of strength** (Isaiah 26:4); He is **transcendent** (Isaiah 55:8-9); He is **immutable** or unchanging (Malachi 3:6); He is **righteous** in all He does (Psalm 11:7).
