I. Consider the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Gifts (1 Peter 4:10-11)

<u>1 Peter 4:10-11</u> As every man hath received the gift, *even so* minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of **God**. <sup>11</sup> If any man speak, *let him speak* as the oracles of **God**; if any man minister, *let him do it* as of the ability which **God** giveth: that **God** in all things may be glorified through **Jesus Christ**, to **Whom** be praise and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

The gift that each of us has been given is the gift of grace as well as individual gifts to be used with that grace.

<u>James 1:17</u> Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the **Father** of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

## II. Consider the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Giver (Romans 12:6a)

- God gives each of His children these gifts to use but also gives us the grace to use them.
- The grace the God gives represents God's power in action.

<u>2 Corinthians 9:8</u> And **God** *is* able to make <u>all</u> grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may abound to every good work:

<u>Philippians 2:13</u> For it is **God** which worketh [energizes] in you both to will [intentional, planned purpose] and to [the power] do of **His** good pleasure [perfect will].
