### III. Our \_\_\_\_\_ in Pursuing the Prize (v. 15-16)

#### A. Encouragement about \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 15)

>>Those who desire the prize need the right perspective—the right frame of mind.<<

##### 1. The \_\_\_\_\_ Mindset

“As many as be perfect” – those \_\_\_\_\_ spiritual perfection / those who \_\_\_\_\_ spiritually mature / those who are \_\_\_\_\_ to being spiritually mature.

- A sanctified dissatisfaction—no \_\_\_\_\_ mindset

**Philippians 3:17** Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.

4. \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Peter 5:10 / James 1:3-4)

**1 Peter 5:10** But the God of all grace, Who hath called us unto His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.
