A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: *Commit* to doing whatever God will say to you in this message *"to obey is better than sacrifice"* (1 Samuel 15:22)

"Our Walk with Purpose"—GLORIFY

Here at PIBC we have adopted a *mission statement* which describes our Biblical purpose.

"To Supremely Love God, Sacrificially Love others, ALL to the glory of God"

Our *mission* is to *glorify* God through our *growth* in **discipleship** and by *going* and **making disciples**.

Our mission is to glorify God as we seek to fulfill our vision and our commission.

Our vision—"to supremely love God"—is an upward focus, seeking to glorify God as we grow, as **disciples**, in His grace and in the knowledge of His Son, thus growing in our love for God.

Romans 13:14 But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to *fulfil* the lusts *thereof*.

5. Our _____ (Romans 12:1)

With our Biblical purpose we see our great privilege as representatives of God as His image-bearer. But with great privilege comes great responsibility.

B. We are to glorify God with our _____ (Matthew 5:13-16)

<u>Acts 1:8</u> But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

1. As salt: resisting _____ (v. 13)

Our influence upon this world is to be deliberate and calculated. It takes effort and faithfulness (Ephesians 4:31-32).

Caution: Salt that loses its flavor loses its influence therefore being worthless.

2. As light: giving _____ (v. 14-15)

Caution: Light that fails to shine in the darkness has no influence and therefore is worthless.

Commitment: (Romans 12:1) – commit to being a living sacrifice so as to faithfully be a light that brings glory to God in fulfilling our created purpose.

<u>Matthew 5:16</u> Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your **Father** which is in heaven.
