"Our Walk as Servants" -- Review

In the last message, "Our Walk as Servants," we considered our role in serving God as we serve others. We noted that our serving others is to be ruled by the law of love.

<u>Galatians 5:13b-14</u> ...but by love serve one another. For all the law is fulfilled in one word, *even* in this; "Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself."

We noted that we honor God as we serve Him with an *attitude of submission* as we serve others in *loving sacrifice*. This is exactly what Christ, Himself, willingly set forth as a pattern for us to follow which we will see in *His walk of obedience* from Philippians 2:5-11.

<u>John 13:15</u> For I have given you an example [a pattern to be imitated], that ye should do as I have done to you.

It is important to point out the simple truth stated here: "ALL creation will bow before Christ Jesus. All creation will confess Him to be Lord of all." The timing of this is important. If a soul bows in humble worship and calls upon Christ to be his Lord in this life, he will spend eternity with Christ in heaven. Humility on earth leads to exaltation in heaven.

Matthew 23:12 And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that

shall humble himself shall be exalted.

If a soul waits and refuses to bow while here on earth, he will bow as he kneels in judgment before the Righteous and Just God, Who will have given a lifetime of grace, yet now must receive the earthly desire of this soul as He assures him into eternal damnation. Self-exaltation on earth leads to eternal humbling in hell.
