<u>John 15:4-5</u> Abide in **Me**, and **I** in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in **Me**. ⁵ **I AM** the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in **Me**, and **I** in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without **Me** ye can do nothing.

I. Jesus' PARABLE of Abiding (John 15:1-8)

Jesus presents us with the parable of abiding in the first 8 verses. We noted the *providence* of the Father as He orchestrates the *painful purging process* in the life of the branch. This led us to the *principle of abiding* which promises a life of "much fruit" as a result.
