<u>Ephesians 1:1</u> Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God , to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus :

"...to the saints..." – It is the Greek word, "hagios." Lit. sacred or _____ ones.

Paul teaches us, in the first 3 chapters of Ephesians, what it means to be "in Christ." This phrase is used 10 different times in these 3 chapters.					
The similar phrases, "in Him," "in the beloved," and "in Whom" are used twice, once, and 7 times respectively. All together Paul emphasizes that we are "in Christ," in one form or another 21 times in the first 3 chapters.

The purpose of this letter is to encourage its readers as it reminds them of their riches in Christ and to live in such a manner that is in line with such a powerful reality. Paul speaks of the WEALTH of the believer that should lead to their WORSHIP in their WORKING and WALKING.

Ephesians 1:2 Grace Jesus Christ.	<i>be</i> to you, and peace	e, from God our Father , and <i>from</i> the Lord			
This word, "grace" is the Greek word, "charis." It can be defined as that which causes joy, and pleasure. It speaks of favor done without expectation of return.					
This word, "peace" speaks of rest, tranquility, and harmony.					
2 Peter 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,					

<u>John 14:27</u> Peace I leave with you, **My** peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

<u>Philippians 2:13</u> For it is **God** which worketh in you both to will [*desire*] and to do of *His* good pleasure.

b. Our ______: "the praise of His glory" (1:12)

Ephesians 1:12 That we should be to the praise of His glory, who first trusted in Christ.

c. Our _____: "walk in good works" (2:10)

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship [masterpiece], created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

d. Our _____: "walk worthy of our calling" (4:1, 11-12)

<u>Ephesians 4:1</u> I therefore, the prisoner of the <u>Lord</u>, beseech you that ye walk worthy [appropriately] of the vocation [calling] wherewith ye are called,

<u>Ephesians 4:11-12</u> And <u>He</u> gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; **12** For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of **Christ**:
