## A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: *Commit* to doing whatever God will say to you in this message *"to obey is better than sacrifice"* (1 Samuel 15:22)

John 15:4-5 Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in Me. <sup>5</sup> I AM the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in Me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without Me ye can do nothing.

## A. The LOVE of Christ (v. 9-11)

Jesus reminds us of the *wonder* of His love in that He loves us with the same love that the Father loves Him. He then spoke to His disciples about the *way* of His love which is obedience. Then He reminded them of the *word* of His love to help us abound in the fruitfulness of joy as we meditate upon these words.

## B. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ (v. 12-17)

John 10:10 "...I AM come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly [*overflowing*]."

1. The LOVE that He \_\_\_\_\_\_(12)

<u>Matthew 5:44</u> But I say unto you, "Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;"

2. The LOVE that He \_\_\_\_\_\_(13)

A MARK OF BEING A FRIEND OF CHRIST IS LOVING OTHERS.

<u>1 John 3:16</u> Hereby perceive we the love *of God,* because He laid down His life for us: and we ought to lay down *our* lives for the brethren.

Our love should be **obvious** and **active**. It should be on full display as we seek to meet the needs of others (1 John 3:17-18).

- 3. The LOVE that He \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 14-15)
  - a. The \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Christ's Friendship (v. 14)

A MARK OF BEING A FRIEND OF CHRIST IS **CONTINUAL** <u>OBEDIENCE</u>.

<u>John 8:31</u> Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on Him, "If ye continue in My Word, *then* are ye My disciples indeed;

A MARK OF BEING A FRIEND OF CHRIST IS <u>KNOWING</u> **DIVINE TRUTH**.

4. The LOVE that He \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 16)

a. Abundant \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 16b)

A MARK OF BEING A FRIEND OF CHRIST IS FRUITFULNESS.

b. Answered \_\_\_\_\_\_ (v. 16c)

A MARK OF BEING A FRIEND OF CHRIST IS <u>CONFIDENT</u> EXPECTATION IN PRAYER.

<u>Hebrews 4:16</u> Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

5. The LOVE that is \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 17)

With these words, Christ sums up what He has been saying all evening. The *law* of *love* should determine our every action.

John 13:35 By this shall all *men* know that ye are **My** disciples, if ye have love one to another."



Our pathway of abounding in fruitfulness is SERVICE—it is what Christ longs for. He desires that we would live the abundant life overflowing with the fruit of the Spirit consistently displayed in our lives in SACRIFICIAL SERVICE toward others.

- 4. What verse(s) should I memorize and meditate upon through-out this week to help make **my** change lasting? (*Renew your mind*)
- 5. In light of what I have heard from God, ... (*Put <u>ON</u> CHRIST*)
  - a. What character quality of Jesus must I demonstrate *with God's help* this week?
  - b. In what situations will I most likely be tempted <u>not</u> to respond in a Christ-like way?
  - c. How can I get ready for those situations? (*If I don't have a plan for change, it probably won't happen.*)
