2. Paul's PRAYER to God (1:15-23)

Paul's prayer is in light of his praise. The "spiritual blessings" contained in his hymn of praise are of such transcendent truths that he feels the need to pray for the recipients of these blessings. He prays for their understanding—that they would be able to comprehend what they have in Christ.
