A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: *Commit* to doing whatever God will say to you in this message "to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15:22)
- I. The WEALTH of the Believer (1:1-3:21)
 - A. The Christian and His RICHES (1:1-23)
 - 1. Paul's PRAISE of God (1:3-14)

Paul's *prayer* is in light of his *praise*. The "*spiritual blessings*" contained in his hymn of praise are of such transcendent truths that he feels the need to pray for the recipients of these blessings. He prays for their understanding—that they would be able to comprehend what they have in Christ.

- a. The PASSION of His Prayer (15-16)
- b. The PURPOSE of His Prayer—ILLUMINATION (17-18a)

He understood that God opens the eyes of our understanding and that we need to humble ourselves and pray to be "enlightened"—for illumination— being dependent upon the Lord for understanding.

- c. The PETITION of His Prayer (17-23)
 - i. KNOWING the <u>PERSON</u> of Christ (17b)
 - ii. KNOWING our <u>POSITION</u> in Christ (18)
 - iii. KNOWING the <u>POWER</u> of Christ (19-20)

<u>Psalm 8:1</u> O LORD our Lord, how excellent is Thy name in all the earth! Who hast set Thy glory above the heavens.

<u>Psalm 113:1-4</u> Praise ye the LORD. Praise, O ye servants of the LORD, praise the name of the LORD. 2 Blessed be the name of the LORD from this time forth and for evermore. 3 From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same the LORD'S name *is* to be praised. 4 The LORD *is* high above all nations, *and* His glory above the heavens.

a) As Head of <u>CREATION</u> (21)

<u>Colossians 2:10</u> And ye are complete in **Him**, which is the head of all principality and power:

He is *"far above all"* kings; *"far above all"* gods; *"far above all"* earthly rulers; *"far above all"* spiritual powers.

<u>1 Peter 3:22</u> Who [*Jesus Christ*] is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of **God**; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto **Him**.

<u>Colossians 1:16-17</u> For by Him [*Christ*] were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him: 17 And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist.

<u>Hebrews 1:3</u> Who being the brightness of *His* glory, and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

<u>Romans 8:38-39</u> For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, **39** Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of **God**, which is in **Christ Jesus** our **Lord**.

b) As Head of the CHURCH (22-23)

<u>Colossians 1:18</u> And He [*Christ*] is the head of the body, the church: Who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all *things* He might have the preeminence.

John 15:4 Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in Me.

Our relationship with Christ as the Head is a living connection in which He has supreme authority. We are to bow in submission to Him.

John 15:5 I AM the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in Me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without Me ye can do nothing.

Christ has been exalted to preeminence. He has been put in "first place." The question remains, "Does He have first place in your life?"



Our WORTHY WALK is the process of understanding the Holy Spirit's ministry of ILLUMINATION that enables us to *"behold wondrous things"* from God's most precious Word. Through

ILLUMINATION we better understand the PERSON of Christ, our POSITION in Him as well as His POWER and PREEMINENCE.
