MAKE A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: Commit to doing whatever God will say to you in this
 message "to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15:22)

 - i. His PRACTICE in Praying—SURRENDER (14-16a)

His prayer is marked by an ATTITUDE of SUBMISSION as he approaches his heavenly Father ACKNOWLEDGING His SOVEREIGNTY and SUFFICIENCY. He comes before God's throne of grace in humility, worshipping His mighty God as he acknowledges what God has done and what He can do.

ii. His PURPOSE in Praying—STRENGTH (16-19)

He prays, not only with the right PERSPECTIVE, but also with PURPOSE. He realizes that a Christian must have spiritual strength in order to faithfully serve and represent their Master, Jesus. In order for this to be a reality, there are some things that are prerequisite.

- a) The Christian's RENEWING--Surrender (16b)
 - 1) He does not STIFLE the Spirit of God
 - 2) He keeps in STEP with the Spirit of God
 - 3) He diligently STUDIES the Word of God

iii. The Christian is RULED—Submission (17a)

a) Christ DWELLING in my heart

The simple question: "Does Christ feel completely at home in my heart / life?"

1) By faith the indwelling of Christ is a REALITY

<u>Romans 8:9-11</u> But ye are not in the flesh, but in the **Spirit**, if so be that the **Spirit** of **God** dwell in you. Now if any man have not the **Spirit** of **Christ**, he is none of **His. 10** And if **Christ** be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the **Spirit** is life because of righteousness. **11** But if the **Spirit** of **Him** that raised up **Jesus** from the dead dwell in you, **He** that raised up **Christ** from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by **His Spirit** that dwelleth in you.

<u>Colossians 1:27</u> To whom **God** would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ** in you, the hope of glory:

2) By faith the indwelling of Christ is REVEALED

<u>John 14:23</u> Jesus answered and said unto him [*Judas, not Iscariot*], "If a man love **Me**, he will keep **My** words: and **My Father** will love him, and **We** will come unto him, and make **Our** abode with him.

<u>John 15:4</u> Abide in **Me**, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in **Me**.

<u>Habakkuk 1:13</u> "*Thou art* of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity: ..."

b) Christ DEALING with my heart

1) The STUDY—My MIND

<u>2 Corinthians 10:5</u> Casting down imaginations [deceptive thoughts], and every high thing [fortresses of thought] that exalteth itself [something raised up in pride] against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity [bring under submission] every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Cf. Philippians 4:8

2) The DINING Room—My DESIRES

<u>1 John 2:16</u> For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the **Father**, but is of the world.

Cf. Colossians 3:2; Psalm 37:4

3) The LIVING Room—My FELLOWSHIP

<u>John 15:4</u> Abide in **Me**, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in **Me**.

<u>John 15:7</u> If ye abide in **Me**, and **My** words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

4) The WORKROOM—My TALENTS

<u>John 15:5</u> I AM the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in **Me**, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without **Me** ye can do nothing.

<u>Philippians 2:13</u> For it is **God** which worketh in you both to will [*desire*] and [*the power*] to do of *His* good pleasure [*perfect will*].

<u>2 Corinthians 3:5</u> Not that we are sufficient [adequate in] of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency [adequacy] is of **God**;

5) The HALL Closet—My HIDDEN SIN

<u>Proverbs 28:13</u> He that covereth his sins [refusal to admit guilt] shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth [acknowledge my sin] and forsaketh [turn from my sin] them shall have mercy.

My Prayer: Psalm 139:23-24 Search [examine intimately] me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: 24 And see if there be any wicked [idolitrous] way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

My Practice: 1Jn 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Cf. Micah 7:18
