#### MAKE A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: *Commit* to doing whatever God will say to you in this message *"to obey is better than sacrifice"* (1 Samuel 15:22)

Paul lays out for us the roadmap of growth and victory in our Christian lives. It is a **LIFE OF REPENTANCE** that leads to a **LIFE OF REFLECTING CHRIST**. This **PROCESS OF CHANGE** that we see in our sanctification is a **PROCESS OF INTENTIONALITY**. It is a process that is **PURPOSEFUL** and therefore effective. When the believer makes little to no effort, according to what Paul teaches us here, the results are often obvious.

This process of change includes both the <u>PURPOSEFUL</u> DEVELOPMENT and <u>PURPOSEFUL</u> DISPLAY OF CHRISTLIKENESS. Within the development process is **REPENTANCE** from sin and **RENEWING** the mind with the Word. Our display of Christ is the **REFLECTION OF HIS GLORY**.

# We have been LIBERATED to LOOK OUTSIDE OURSELVES a. LIBERATED from the POWER of SIN

<u>Romans 6:6-7</u> Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with *Him*, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. **7** For he that is dead is freed from sin.

<u>Romans 6:11</u> Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

<u>Romans 6:22</u> But now being made free from sin, and become servants to **God**, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

#### b. LIBERATED to PURSUE LOVING SERVICE

<u>Galatians 5:1</u> Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

<u>Galatians 5:13</u> For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only *use* not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

CHRISTIAN LIBERTY ENCOURAGES LOVING SERVICE.

#### 2. We have been LIBERATED to LOVE OUTSIDE OURSELVES

<u>Philippians 2:3-4</u> Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. **4** Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

**Philippians 2:5** Let this mind be in you, which was also in **Christ Jesus**:

a. With our WITNESS— to be GENUINE to others (v. 25) MOTIVATED by a FAMILY community

b. With our WRATH—to be GRACIOUS to others (v. 26-27) MOTIVATED by the UNITY of the community

c. With our WORK—to GIVE to others (v. 28) MOTIVATED by the NEEDS of the community

d. With our WORDS—to GROW others (29-30) MOTIVATED by the MATURITY of the community

### e. With our WILL—to be GODLIKE to others (31-32) MOTIVATED by the MERCY of Christ



Our WORTHY WALK is explained by WALKING IN LIBERTY. Through obedience, we are to "*put off*" those SINFUL MARKS of BONDAGE that DIVIDE the community of Christ. In turn we are to "*put on*" those CHRISTLIKE MARKS of LIBERTY which

UNITE the body of Christ. We are to be MOTIVATED by the UNITY and MATURITY of the community and the MERCY OF CHRIST.
