MAKE A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: *Commit* to doing whatever God will say to you in this message "to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15:22)
- I. The WEALTH of the Believer (1:1-3:21)
- II. The WALK of the Believer (4:1-6:9)
 - A. Walk WORTHY—VERTICALLY before GOD (4:1-32)
 - B. Walk WORTHY—HORIZONTALLY toward OTHERS (5:1-6:9)
 - 1. Walk in LOVE DISPLAYING the LOVE of CHRIST (5:1-2)
 - 2. Walk in LIGHT REFLECTING the LIGHT of CHRIST (5:3-14)

Paul turns to our INFLUENCE. Following his call for us to love like our heavenly Father by imitating the sacrificial love of our Savior, we are now called upon to walk in light in the way that we love.

a. The DARKNESS of the WORLD (3-6)

We must REFRAIN from living like the darkened world around us but instead, live with SELF-CONTROL, CONTENTMENT, and engage in GODLY CONVERSATION.

b. The LIGHT of CHRIST (7-14)

Paul now turns from **DARKNESS** to **LIGHT**. He spoke of the **DARKNESS OF THE WORLD** and now he turns to the **LIGHT OF CHRIST**.

i. Paul gives the BELIEVER a REMINDER (7-10)

He reminded us of WHO WE WERE and will now remind us of WHO WE ARE.

ii. Paul speaks of the BELIEVER'S RESPONSIBILITY (11-14)

Our greatest influence as "salt" and "light" comes from faithfully living out the light of God's Word in our Jerusalem. It is through our faithful response to the ministry of God's Word as we live out these truths in the normal rhythms of life. This is doing the "work of the ministry" for which we are equipped to do through the ministry of God's Word.

<u>2</u> Timothy 3:16-17 All scripture *is* given by inspiration of **God**, and *is* profitable [*beneficial*] for doctrine [*teaching what is truth*], for reproof [*conviction of sin / what is wrong*], for correction [*how to make the wrong right*], for instruction in righteousness [*how to stay right*]: **17** That the man of **God** may be perfect, throughly furnished [*equipped fully*] unto all good works.

a) The COMMAND against CO-PARTICIPATION (11a)

<u>1 Corinthians 5:11</u> But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is <u>called a brother</u> be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.

b) The COMMISSION as AGENTS of <u>CONVICTION</u>— <u>LIVE</u> the WORD OF TRUTH (11b)

"...but rather reprove them." (Eph 5:11) – This word "reprove" speaks of exposing something. It carries the idea of conviction through rebuke.

Through a 2 Timothy 3:16-17 life, a believer lives as an AGENT OF CONVICTION living a life of *lighted truth* in a Jerusalem of *darkened deception*. Their life then exposes WHAT IS WRONG bringing CONVICTION.

c) The CONVERSATION of the ACTS of CORRUPTION (12)

<u>Proverbs 6:23</u> For the Commandment *is* a lamp [*for guidance*]; and the Law *is* light; and reproofs [*corrections*] of instruction *are* the way of life:

d) The COMMISSION as AGENTS of <u>CORRECTION</u>— <u>SPEAK</u> the WORD OF TRUTH (13)

"But all things that are reproved are made manifest by the light: ..." (Eph_5:13) – This word "*reprove*" speaks of exposing something.

This word, "manifest" speaks of making something visible.

<u>John 16:8</u> And when He [the Holy Spirit] is come, He will reprove [convince] the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

A Christian's life is to expose sin as an AGENT OF <u>CORRECTION</u> helping the sinner to see HOW TO MAKE THE WRONG <u>RIGHT</u> through the hope that is in Jesus Christ. It is through the life and light of the believer that the sin of his Jerusalem is exposed but also shown how to be right. This is a call to action!

e) The CALL to AWAKEN to the CORRECTION— RECEIVE the WORD OF TRUTH (14)

<u>Isaiah 55:6-7</u> Seek ye the LORD while He may be found, call ye upon Him while He is near: 7 Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and He will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.

As an AGENT OF <u>CALLING</u>, the believer invites lost souls to Christ. Through the applied ministry of the *"instruction in righteousness"* a soul is shown HOW TO STAY <u>RIGHT</u> through a personal relationship with Christ, the One Who is able to give life and light." He is the answer.

<u>Psalm 145:18</u> The LORD *is* nigh unto all them that call upon Him, to all that call upon Him <u>in truth</u>.

<u>Matthew 5:16</u> Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your **Father** which is in heaven.
