MAKE A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: Commit to doing whatever God will say to you in this
 message "to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15:22)
- I. The WEALTH of the Believer (1:1-3:21)
- II. The WALK of the Believer (4:1-6:9)
 - A. Walk WORTHY—VERTICALLY before GOD (4:1-32)

In Ephesians 4, Paul addresses our "worthy walk" as it relates VERTICALLY BEFORE GOD. In these verses he addresses some key areas which help PREPARE the believer be more effective in his ministry HORIZONTALLY TOWARD OTHERS. In order for each of us to HORIZONTALLY minister to others, we must first take care of our VERTICAL relationship before God.

- B. Walk WORTHY—HORIZONTALLY toward OTHERS (5:1-6:9)
 - 1. Walk in LOVE DISPLAYING the LOVE of CHRIST (5:1-2)
 - 2. Walk in LIGHT REFLECTING the LIGHT of CHRIST (5:3-14)
 - 3. Walk in WISDOM in the WORD of CHRIST (5:15-17)
 - 4. Walk in STEP with the SPIRIT of CHRIST (5:18-21)

Keep in mind the context that this section falls within. Paul is speaking about our INFLUENCE in our WORTHY WALK, HORIZONTALLY toward others. The law of love is to determine our attitude. "...but by love serve one another."—Galatians 5:13b

To WALK IN LOVE is to live a life of loving sacrifice to our Jerusalem as we display our supreme love for the Father.

- a. The COMMAND to Walk in the Spirit (18)
 - A LACK of SELF-CONTROL (18a)
 - The COMMAND to make a CHOICE
 - b) FAILING to CHOOSE brings CHANGE
 - c) The CHANGE brings a CONSEQUENCE

ii. A LOT of SPIRIT CONTROL (18b)

SELF-CONTROL IS BEST ACCOMPLISHED BY BEING CONTROLLED BY GOD'S SPIRIT.

<u>1 Corinthians 6:12</u> All things are lawful [permissible] unto me, but all things are not expedient [good for me to do]: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power [the control] of any.

a) The COMMAND calls for a deliberate CHOICE

Here in <u>Ephesians 5:18</u>, the implication here is a <u>CONTROLLING</u> or DOMINATING INFLUENCE. This idea is clearly seen in the usage of this Greek word in the NT (<u>John 16:6</u>; <u>Acts 5:3</u>; <u>Acts 5:17-18</u>).

b) The CONSTRUCTION calls for a repeated OCCURRENCE

With the grammatical construction, Paul is saying, "Be constantly being filled with the Spirit" (Wuest).

c) Our CONDITION calls for diligent COOPERATION

Being Spirit-filled is dependent upon our YIELDEDNESS to God's will.

<u>Philippians 2:13</u> For it is **God** which worketh in you both to will [*desire*] and to do [*the power*] of *His* good pleasure [*perfect will*].

<u>Galatians 5:16</u> This I say then, "Walk in the **Spirit**, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh."

d) The CHALLENGE calls for a saturating CONCENTRATION

<u>Colossians 3:16</u> Let the Word of <u>Christ</u> dwell in you richly [<u>abundantly</u>] in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the <u>Lord</u>.

<u>James 1:25</u> But whoso looketh [to look with <u>great care</u>] into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

e) Our COOPERATION brings a delightful CHANGE

<u>2 Corinthians 3:18</u> But we all, with open face [*unobstructed view*] beholding as in a glass [*a mirror*] the glory of the **Lord**, are changed [*metamorphosis*] into the same image from glory to glory, *even* as by the **Spirit** of the **Lord**.

<u>Galatians 5:22-23</u> But the fruit of the **Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, **23** Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

- 1. A SPIRIT-FILLED Demonstration
- A WORD-FILLED Demonstration

Being "filled" with God's Spirit and being "filled" with God's Word brings the same result because a Word-filled believer is dominated by <u>truth</u> therefore having the mind of Christ. It is through the work of the SPIRIT OF GOD as He takes WORD OF GOD and transforms the believer into the likeness of the SON OF GOD.



Our WORTHY WALK is further explained by WALKING IN STEP with the SPIRIT of CHRIST. A COMMAND is given to YIELD to the SPIRIT'S CONTROL by making a DELIBERATE and

REPEATED CHOICE, participating in DILIGENT COOPERATION and SATURATING CONCENTRATION anticipating a DELIGHTFUL CHANGE.
