MAKE A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: Commit to doing whatever God will say to you in this
 message "to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15:22)
- The WEALTH of the Believer (1:1-3:21)
- II. The WALK of the Believer (4:1-6:9)

A. Walk WORTHY—VERTICALLY before GOD (4:1-32)

In Ephesians 4, Paul addresses our "worthy walk" as it relates VERTICALLY BEFORE GOD. In these verses he addresses some key areas which help PREPARE the believer be more effective in his ministry HORIZONTALLY TOWARD OTHERS. In order for each of us to HORIZONTALLY minister to others, we must first take care of our VERTICAL relationship before God.

- B. Walk WORTHY—HORIZONTALLY toward OTHERS (5:1-6:9)
 - 1. Walk in LOVE DISPLAYING the LOVE of CHRIST (5:1-2)
 - 2. Walk in LIGHT REFLECTING the LIGHT of CHRIST (5:3-14)
 - 3. Walk in WISDOM in the WORD of CHRIST (5:15-17)
 - 4. Walk in STEP with the SPIRIT of CHRIST (5:18-21)
 - 5. Walk in HARMONY in the WAY of CHRIST (5:22-6:9)
 - a. Introduction: The Mystery of Marriage (5:31-33)



Our WORTHY WALK is explained by WALKING IN HARMONY in the WAY of CHRIST. We saw how the MARRIAGE INSTITUTION has been CORRUPTED, which has led to our MARRIAGE INFLUENCE being in

CRISIS. Yet within the "great mystery" of marriage we see that MARRIAGE is ILLUSTRATED best in the GOSPEL of JESUS CHRIST. Thus, we must commit to keeping God as the final AUTHORITY OF MARRIAGE, CHRIST as the OBJECT OF

MARRIAGE, and faithfulness in our OBEDIENCE IN MARRIAGE.

- a. The MARRIAGE RELATIONSHIP (5:22-33)
 - GODLY WIVES Practice WILLFULLY LOVING SUBMISSION (22-24)

It is important that each of us maintain HUMILITY OF MIND, MEEKNESS TOWARD GOD, PATIENCE and LOVE TOWARD OTHERS, SEEKING A UNIFIED COMMUNITY as we seek to understand our OWN RESPONSIBILITIES within each section of teaching.

a) The PRECEPT of Submission COMMANDED (22)

An important key to this passage is to keep in mind the context along with its sister passage—"be filled with the Spirit" (Eph 5:18) and "Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly" (Col 3:16). Godly wives demonstrate being SPIRIT-FILLED and WORD-FILLED as the willingly and lovingly submit to their "own husbands, as unto the Lord."

<u>Colossians 3:18</u> Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the **Lord**.

1. A willing attitude—"submit yourselves"

Biblical submission does not refer to PASSIVITY but INTENTIONALITY.

Consider the great place of influence in submission (1 Peter 3:1-4).

<u>1 Peter 3:4</u> But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart [*the real you*], in that which is not corruptible [*imperishable*], *even the ornament* of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of **God** of great price [*extremely expensive*].

2. A loving attitude—"your own husband"

<u>Titus 2:4-5</u> That they [the aged women] may teach the young women to be sober [self-controlled], to love their husbands, to love their children, **5** To be discreet [sensible], chaste [pure], keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed [dishonored].

3. An attitude of worship—"as unto the Lord"

Everything in this passage points to Christ. The goal of Biblical submission is to glorify God. The goal of marriage is to glorify God.

<u>1 Corinthians 10:31</u> Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of **God**.

Never forget that God is infinitely wise and good. All that He calls us to do is for our best and ultimately for His glory. Never forget the nature of God as you read His Word.

- b) The PICTURE of Submission ILLUSTRATED (23-24)
 - A GODLY HUSBAND is a PICTURE of CHRIST'S HEADSHIP (23)

<u>1 Corinthians 11:3</u> But I would have you know, that the head of every man is **Christ**; and the head of the woman *is* the man; and the head of **Christ** *is* **God**.

Biblical **submission does not refer to INEQUALITY but <u>HIERARCHY</u>** (Galatians 3:28; Colossians 3:11).

Submission does not refer to ABILITY but God's <u>CREATED</u> ORDER (Genesis 2:18, 21-22).

2. A GODLY WIFE is a PICTURE of the CHURCH'S SUBMISSION (24)

Followers of Christ are to display their love for God in their obedience to Him (John 13:34-35; Joh 14:15).

"...so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in everything." (Eph 5:24) – This phrase, "in everything" must be taking in harmony with the Word of God, understanding that a wife's submission is to be in line with God's Word.



Our WORTHY WALK is explained by WALKING IN HARMONY in the WAY of CHRIST. GODLY WIVES practice WILLING and LOVING SUBMISSION as an ACT OF WORSHIP "as unto the Lord." A "meek and quiet spirit is in the sight of God of great price."
