God designed marriage as the foundational institution of human society. God designed marriage for one man and one woman to be joined together in this life-long sacred union.

It is important we each of us maintain HUMILITY OF MIND, MEEKNESS TOWARD GOD, PATIENCE and LOVE TOWARD OTHERS, SEEKING A UNIFIED COMMUNITY as we seek to understand our OWN RESPONSIBILITIES

within each section of teaching. *Wives*, as your husband is being addressed, humbly consider how you can come alongside him to LOVINGLY and HUMBLY ENCOURAGE HIM in HIS OBEDIENCE TO THE LORD, maintaining PATIENCE WITH HIM as HE LEARNS and GROWS.

- a) The PRECEPT of LOVE COMMANDED (25a)
- b) The PICTURE of LOVE ILLUSTRATED (25b)
- c) The PRACTICE of LOVE <u>DEMONSTRATED</u> (26-32)

To love with this cross-shaped "agapao" love of Christ, there must be a determination to love in this manner. The husband must determine to demonstrate this kind of Christlike love to his wife. Christlike love is demonstrated when a husband DETERMINES TO LOVE, seeking to love with the SACRIFICIAL LOVE of Christ.

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"Is your wife more like Christ because she is married to you? Or, is she like Christ in spite of you?"

#### 1. DETERMINE a PURIFYING LOVE (26)

A PURIFYING LOVE has the PROCESS in mind. It seeks to help our wives on their journey of sanctification. It to encourage them in their pursuit of Christlikeness.

### 2. DETERMINE a <u>PERFECTING</u> LOVE (27)

Husbands, our PERFECTING LOVE looks forward to the day we stand before the Lord and GIVE ACCOUNT for the **life we lived** and the **way we loved**.

# 3. DETERMINE a PERSONAL LOVE (28-30)

Together, these words, "nourish" and "cherish" speak to the overall care of a husband toward his wife. He is to care for her, not simply for her minimal existence, but for her every need seeking to promote in her a life that overflows. His goal is to help her reach her full potential.

# 4. DETERMINE a PERMANENT LOVE (31)

<u>Genesis 2:24</u> Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

#### a. It is a LOVE that LEAVES

This a love that leaves, other relationships, as it sets a higher priority of loyalty upon their spouse.

#### b. It is a LOVE that <u>CLEAVES</u>

Paul speaks of the permanence of the marriage union. In God's eyes, a marriage union is dissolved only by death.

<u>Romans 7:2</u> For the woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to *her* husband so long as he liveth; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed [released] from the law of *her* husband.

In marriage, when we operate by God's design, divorce is not a consideration for God hates divorce (Mal 2:16). When a husband sacrificially and selflessly loves his wife and she in turn willingly submits to his leadership, there is no need to consider divorce.

#### c. It is a LOVE that WEAVES

"...and they two shall be one flesh." (Eph 5:31) – This phrase, "one flesh" speaks complete unity as two souls are united as one. Notice the harmony of unity.

This speaks of the weaving process of the marriage relationship whereby two lives are woven into one.

## 1 Corinthians 13:8 Charity never faileth: ...

A love that truly cleaves and weaves is a love that never fails.

Our WORTHY WALK is explained by WALKING IN HARMONY in the WAY of CHRIST. GODLY HUSBANDS practice INTENTIONAL LOVING INFLUENCE. They determine to love

their wife with a PERMANENT LOVE that displays a progressing harmonious unity. It is A LOVE THAT LEAVES, setting a higher priority on their wife. It is A LOVE THAT CLEAVES, being joined permanently to her in a life-long sacred union. It is also A LOVE THAT WEAVES together each other's personalities and desires.
