It is important we each of us maintain HUMILITY OF MIND, MEEKNESS TOWARD GOD, PATIENCE and LOVE TOWARD OTHERS, SEEKING A UNIFIED COMMUNITY as we seek to understand our OWN RESPONSIBILITIES within each section of teaching. *Wives*, as your husband is being addressed, humbly consider how you can come alongside him to

LOVINGLY and HUMBLY ENCOURAGE HIM in HIS OBEDIENCE TO THE LORD, maintaining PATIENCE WITH HIM as HE LEARNS and GROWS.

- "Is your wife more like Christ because she is married to you? Or, is she like Christ in spite of you?"
 - 1. DETERMINE a <u>PURIFYING</u> LOVE (26)
 - 2. DETERMINE a <u>PERFECTING</u> LOVE (27)
 - 3. DETERMINE a PERSONAL LOVE (28-30)

"This is a great mystery: ..." (Eph 5:32) — The Greek word, "mustērion" is translated "mystery" which carries the idea of a secret thing that is unknown to human reasoning.

The marriage union is a profound mystery when we consider the uniting of two individual lives that produce a stronger, more unified influence.

"...but I speak concerning Christ and the church." (<u>Eph 5:32</u>) – This mystery is not due to its difficulty to understand but the profound reality of what it accomplishes. Now, Paul applies it directly to the marriage union.

MARRIAGE IS TO BE A BEAUTIFUL PICTURE OF THE GOSPEL ON DISPLAY.

- d) The PRECEPTS of LOVE REMINDED (33)
 - GODLY HUSBANDS practice SACRIFICIAL and SELFLESS LOVE

"Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; ..." (Eph_5:33) – Paul stresses love not authority. He emphasizes the love that the husband is to display.

Q: The key question a Godly husband seeks to ask himself is, "Does my love for my wife reveal the characteristics of Christ's love for His church?"

- a. "Is it a <u>PURIFYING</u> love?"
- b. "Is it a **PERFECTING** love?"

- c. "Is it a PERSONAL love?"
- d. "Is it a PERMANENT love?"
- e. "It is a PROFOUND love?"

2. GODLY WIVES practice WILLING and LOVING SUBMISSION

"...and the wife see that she reverence her husband." (Eph 5:33) — The Greek word translated "reverence" carries the idea of respect and awe.

A Godly wife is to be <u>INTENTIONAL</u> in how she submits to her husband.

A Godly wife is to be **INFLUENTIAL** in how she submits to her husband.

Q: The key question a Godly wife seeks to ask herself is, "Does my submission to my husband reveal the characteristics of my Savior's to His Father?"

- Is my submission WILLING?
- ii. Is my submission LOVING?
- iii. Is my submission WORSHIP?



Our WORTHY WALK is explained by WALKING IN HARMONY in the WAY of CHRIST. GODLY HUSBANDS practice INTENTIONAL LOVE. They determine to love their wife with a

PROFOUND LOVE. A Godly husband DETERMINES to love his wife with the CROSS-SHAPED LOVE OF CHRIST. GODLY HUSBANDS practice SACRIFICIAL and SELFLESS LOVE. While a GODLY WIFE DETERMINES to practice WILLING and LOVING SUBMISSION to her own husband.
