MAKE A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: *Commit* to doing whatever God will say to you in this message "to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15:22)
- I. The WEALTH of the Believer (Ephesians 1:1-3:21)
- II. The WALK of the Believer (4:1-6:9)

We note that our understanding of the PRINCIPLES of GOD'S WORD will lead to the PRACTICE of GOD'S WAYS.

- A. Walk WORTHY—VERTICALLY before GOD (4:1-32)
- B. Walk WORTHY—HORIZONTALLY toward OTHERS (5:1-6:9)
 - 1. Walk in <u>Love</u>, DISPLAYING CHRIST'S <u>Love</u> for You (5:1-2)
 - 2. Walk in Light, REFLECTING CHRIST'S Light in You (5:3-14)
 - 3. Walk in Wisdom, LIVING the WORD of CHRIST before You (5:15-17)
 - 4. Walk in the Spirit, being IN STEP with CHRIST'S SPIRIT in You (5:18-21)
 - 5. Walk in Harmony, in the WAY CHRIST has for You (5:22-6:9)
 - a. The Marriage Relationship (Ephesians 5:22-33)
 - i. Godly WIVES Practice Willing and Loving SUBMISSION (5:22-24)
 - ii. Godly HUSBANDS practice Sacrificial and Selfless LOVE (5:25-33)

i. Godly CHILDREN Practice Loving and Submissive OBEDIENCE (Ephesians 6:1-3)

Psalm 127:3 Lo, children *are* an heritage of the **LORD**: *and* the fruit of the womb *is His* reward.

a) The <u>Precept</u> of Obedience <u>Commanded</u> (1)

"Children, obey your parents in the Lord: ..." (Ephesians 6:1) – To "obey" carries the action of *listening* with the attitude of *submission*.

Colossians 3:20 Children, obey *your* parents in all things: for this is well-pleasing unto the **Lord**.

Proverbs 4:1 Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding.

b) The <u>Practice</u> of Respect <u>Determined</u> (2a)

"Honor thy father and mother;..." (Ephesians 6:2) – To "honor" is to set a value upon something.

- 1. Determine to Obey Quickly
- 2. Determine to Obey Sweetly
- 3. Determine to Obey Completely
- c) The **Promise** of Blessing **Motivated** (2b-3)

ii. Godly FATHERS practice Loving AUTHORITY (4)

DUTY = "I have to!" vs. DEVOTION = "I get to!"

a) The **Precept** of Love Commanded (4a)

This Greek word translated, "provoke to wrath," carries the idea anger, irritation, and frustration leading to resentment.

Colossians 3:21 Fathers, provoke not your children *to anger,* lest they be discouraged.

b) The **Practice** of Love **Determined** (4b)

To "bring them up" speaks of rearing up to <u>maturity</u>. The goal is redemptive as we seek to help them come to KNOW JESUS and then help them to GROW TO BE LIKE JESUS.

In Deuteronomy 6, we see God's command to parents which has not changed.

- 1. Teach them Who God is (Deuteronomy 6:4)
- 2. Teach them to Love God (Deu. 6:5)
- 3. Teach them to Obey God (Deu. 6:6)
- 4. Show them how to **Follow** God (Deu. 6:7)

Our WORTHY WALK is explained by WALKING IN HARMONY in the WAY of CHRIST. **GODLY CHILDREN** practice INTENTIONAL LOVING OBEDIENCE, with attitudes of SURRENDER, LOVE, WORSHIP, and SUBMISSION. They DETERMINE to obey their parents QUICKLY, SWEETLY, and COMPLETELY. **GODLY PARENTS** practice INTENTIONAL LOVING AUTHORITY. They determine to love their children by teaching through their own example and love for God.
