MAKE A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: *Commit* to doing whatever God will say to you in this message *"to obey is better than sacrifice"* (1 Samuel 15:22)
- I. The WEALTH of the Believer (Ephesians 1:1-3:21)
- II. The WALK of the Believer (4:1-6:9)
 - A. Walk WORTHY—VERTICALLY before GOD (4:1-32)
 - B. Walk WORTHY—HORIZONTALLY toward OTHERS (5:1-6:9)

Keep in mind the context that this section falls within. Paul is speaking about our REDEMPTIVE INFLUENCE in our WORTHY WALK, HORIZONTALLY toward others.

- 1. Walk in Love, DISPLAYING CHRIST'S Love for You (5:1-2)
- 2. Walk in Light, REFLECTING CHRIST'S Light in You (5:3-14)
- 3. Walk in <u>Wisdom</u>, LIVING the WORD of CHRIST before You (5:15-17)
- 4. Walk in the Spirit, being IN STEP with CHRIST'S SPIRIT in You (5:18-21)
- 5. Walk in Harmony, in the WAY CHRIST has for You (5:22-6:9)
 - a. The Marriage Relationship (Ephesians 5:22-33)
 - i. Godly WIVES Practice Willing and Loving SUBMISSION (22-24)
 - ii. Godly HUSBANDS practice Sacrificial and Selfless LOVE (25-33)
 - b. The Family Relationships (Ephesians 6:1-4)
 - i. Godly CHILDREN Practice Loving and Submissive OBEDIENCE (1-3)
 - ii. Godly FATHERS practice Loving AUTHORITY (4)

c. The Work Relationships (6:5-9)

The Gospel is the great reconciler. As enemies are reconciled to Christ they can be united with each other in a relationship of harmony and peace (Ephesians 2:11-15).

Is there a difference between secular work and sacred work?

i. Godly Employees Practice Loving and Submissive OBEDIENCE (Ephesians 6:5-8)

Titus 2:9-10 *Exhort* servants to be obedient unto their own masters, *and* to please *them* well in all *things*; not answering again; **10** Not purloining, but shewing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of **God** our **Saviour** in all things.

a) The <u>Precept</u> of OBEDIENCE Commanded—"be obedient" (Ephesians 6:5a)

Colossians 3:22 Servants, obey in all things *your* masters according to the flesh; but in singleness of heart, fearing **God**:"

- b) The <u>Practice</u> of OBEDIENCE Determined (Ephesians 6:5b-7)
 - 1. The Right <u>Upward</u> <u>Awe</u>—"with fear and trembling" (Ephesians 6:5b)
 - 2. The Right <u>Upward</u> <u>Attention</u>—"in singleness of heart, as unto Christ" (Eph. 6:5c)

3. The Right <u>Outward Attention</u>—"not with eyeservice" (Ephesians 6:6a)

Proverbs 5:21 For the ways of man *are* before the eyes of the LORD, and He pondereth [*carefully*] all his goings.

Galatians 1:10 For do I now persuade men, or **God**? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should NOT be the servant of **Christ**.

Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do *it* heartily [*from the soul*], as to the **Lord**, and not unto men;

c) The **Promise** that OBEDIENCE Motivates (8)

Colossians 3:24 Knowing that of the **Lord** ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the **Lord Christ**.

Colossians 3:25 But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.

ii. Godly Employers Practice Loving AUTHORITY (Ephesians 6:9)

Colossians 4:1 Masters, give unto *your* servants that which is just and equal; knowing that ye also have a **Master** in heaven.

a) Your <u>Motivating</u>—"forbearing threatening"

b) Your <u>Master</u>—"knowing that your Master also is in heaven"

Our WORTHY WALK is explained by WALKING IN HARMONY in the WAY of CHRIST. **GODLY EMPLOYEE** practice INTENTIONAL LOVING OBEDIENCE, with the Right **UPWARD AWE**, seeking the Right **UPWARD** and **OUTWARD ATTENTION**, all with the RIGHT INWARD ATTITUDE.

GODLY EMPLOYERS practice INTENTIONAL LOVING AUTHORITY. They DETERMINE to use the right kind of MOTIVATION as they serve their MASTER in heaven.
