- "Do I really want to fight him at all? Am I sincere about this spiritual warfare?"
 - ii. He is <u>righteous</u> in his <u>testimony</u>—He is <u>characterized</u> by holiness (Ephesians 6:14b)
- [a] "Am I living the kind of life that enables me to engage in this conflict?"
 - iii. He is <u>resolute</u> where he <u>treads</u>—He is <u>confident</u> & <u>courageous</u> in his faith (Ephesians 6:15)
- "Am I prepared to fight?" "Am I bold in the battle, because my feet are firmly rooted in Gospel of peace?"

iv. He is <u>ready</u> for <u>temptation</u>—He is <u>counteractive</u> in the face of temptation (Eph. 6:16)

"Am I able to defend myself against Satan's attack?"

"Taking up the shield of faith" is living with active or dynamic faith. It is putting your faith into action—doing what you say that you believe.

"...wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked [one]." (Eph. 6:16) — We note that the sufficiency of this "shield of faith" in that it "quenches [or extinguishes] ALL the fiery darts of the wicked one."

Faith diffuses the temptation as it does away with dependency upon self. This "faith" is our belief in God—what we believe to be true about God. Therefore, "faith" is stepping out into the light of Christ based upon the truths of God's Word.

1 John 5:4 For whatsoever is born of **God** overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, *even* our faith.

Consider how we fight with the "shield of faith" against the tempter.

a) Be <u>Sober</u> in Thought (8)

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober [self-controlled], be vigilant [on guard / alert]; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

Matthew 26:41 Watch [be vigilant] and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

1 Corinthians 10:13 "There hath no temptation taken you but such as [except what] is common to man: but **God** is faithful, **Who** will not suffer [allow] you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear [endure] it."

Acknowledge what God says in His Word about temptation. The right perspective is to THINK YOUR WAY THROUGH A TEMPTATION!

- 1) acknowledge what is **COMMOND** acknowledge where the component which is acknowledge where the
- 2) Acknowledge your Creator

Proverbs 30:5 Every word of **God** *is* pure: **He** *is* a shield [*a sure protection*] unto them that put their trust [*seek refuge*] in **Him**.

- 3) Acknowledge His Control
- 4) Acknowledge His COVENANT

b) Be **Steadfast** in Faith (9)

<u>1 Peter 5:9</u> Whom resist [to stand against or oppose] stedfast [being firm or stable] in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

Consider Abraham's Example (Romans 4:18-22 / Hebrews 11:17-19)

Having faith determines that God is Who He says He is and it determines that God will do what He says He will do.

c) Be **Strong** in the Lord (10)

- **1 Peter 5:10** "But the **God** of all grace, **Who** hath called us unto **His** eternal glory by **Christ Jesus**, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect [*mature*], stablish, strengthen, settle [*stabilize*] *you*."
- **2 Corinthians 9:8** "And **God** *is* able to make <u>all</u> grace [*divine help*] abound [*superabound/in excess*] toward you; that ye, <u>always</u> having <u>all</u> sufficiency [*being content or satisfied*] in <u>all</u> things, may abound to <u>every</u> good work:"
- 1 Peter 5:11 "To Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen."
- **1 Peter 1:7** "That the trial [*proving*] of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of **Jesus Christ**:"

Our WARFARE is fought with the INSTRUMENTS of God. Our protection for the spiritual battles of life continues with being READY FOR TEMPTATION. He knows how to COUNTERACT the temptations of the devil by being SOBER in thought, STEADFAST in faith, and STRONG IN THE LORD.
