iii. He is <u>resolute</u> where he <u>treads</u> (v. 6:15)

With GOSPEL SHOES, the soldier of Christ displays **courageous** faith.

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With the SHIELD OF FAITH, the soldier of Christ displays **counteractive** faith.

v. He is <u>resolved</u> in his <u>thoughts</u>—He is <u>confident</u> with the hope of salvation (v. 6:17a)

Eph 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation [protecting the mind], ...

- "Am I able to defend myself against Satan's attacking doubts?"

 With the HELMET OF SALVATION, the soldier of Christ displays

 confident faith.
- **1** Thessalonians **5:8** But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an **helmet**, **the hope of salvation**.
- **2 Timothy 1:12b** ... for I know **Whom** I have believed, and am persuaded that **He** is able to keep that which I have committed unto **Him** against that day.
