MAKE A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: Commit to doing whatever God will say to you in this
 message "to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Samuel 15:22)

I. The Wealth of the Believer (Ephesians 1:1-3:21)

Question from Ch. 1-3: "What it is to be a Christian?"

In the first 3 chapters we learn why we should have an unparalleled DEVOTION TO GOD. In chapter 1 we see our RICHES in Christ. Then in chapter 2 Paul explains our RECONCILIATION to Christ. Finally, in chapter 3, Paul speaks of the REVELATION of Christ's love for us.

II. The Walk of the Believer (Ephesians 4:1-6:9)

Ouestion from Ch. 4-6: "How to live as a Christian?"

We see how a transforming understanding of these DOCTRINAL TRUTHS lead to a lifestyle of DEVOTION to God as we pursue this DEVELOPMENT OF CHRISTLIKENESS through our diligent study of His Word. This is followed by the DISPLAY OF CHRISTLIKENESS as we put into practice these truths of God in both our walk and warfare.



III. The Warfare of the Believer (Ephesians 6:10-20)

Question from Ch. 6: "How to continue forward as a Christian?"

In Ephesians 6 Paul commands us to CONTINUE FORWARD as we consider the WARFARE of the believer. We are to take PRAYERFUL STEPS OF FAITH engaging in battle as we employ the armor of God. We noted that SUFFICIENT PREPARATION is followed by SUCCESSFUL PRACTICE.

IV. The Walk of the Believer Continuing FORWARD (Eph. 6:21-24)

John 8:31 Then said **Jesus** to those Jews which believed on **Him**, "If ye continue [abide] in **My** Word, then are ye **My** disciples indeed;

John 14:23-24 Jesus answered and said unto him, "If a man love Me, he will keep My words: and My Father will love him, and We will come unto him, and make Our abode with him. 24 He that loveth Me not keepeth not My sayings: and the word which ye hear is not Mine, but the Father's which sent Me.

A. Paul's Ministry Partner (Ephesians 6:21-22)

- 1. Tychicus was **Beneficial** (Eph. 6:21)
 - a. He was a beloved colleague—"a beloved brother"
 - b. He was a trusted colleague —"a faithful minister"

As a "faithful minister," Tychicus was responsive to the needs of others.

2. Tychicus was a Blessing (Eph. 6:22)

Colossians 4:7-8 All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you, who is a beloved brother, and a faithful minister and fellowservant in the Lord: **8** Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and comfort your hearts;

B. Paul's Meaningful Prayer (Ephesians 6:23-24)

1. Our Expression of Dynamic Faith is Peace & Love (Eph. 6:23)



This "faith" is our belief in God—what we believe to be true about God. Therefore, dynamic/ <u>active</u> "faith" is stepping out into the light of Christ based upon the truths of God's Word.

a. Pursue Peace with others

Throughout this letter to the saints in Ephesus, Paul repeatedly speaks of how peace with God is to lead to peace with others (Ephesians 2:14-17).

b. Practice Sacrificial Love for others

Ephesians 4:2-3 [Walk worthy (v. 1)] With all lowliness [humility] and meekness, with longsuffering [bearing patiently], forbearing one another in love; **3** Endeavouring to keep the unity of the **Spirit** in the bond of peace.

Throughout this letter to the saints in Ephesus, Paul repeatedly calls for the saints to display sacrificial love in their relationships (Ephesians 4:15-16).

John 13:35 By this shall all *men* know that ye are **My** disciples, if ye have love one to another."

2. God's Enablement of Dynamic Faith is Grace (Eph. 6:24)

God's "grace" enables the believer to express their faith and display this "sincere" or imperishable "love" for the "Lord Jesus Christ."

Obedience is the expression of our unfailing love for our Savior (John 14:15). This is enabled by the "grace" of God (1 Peter 5:5-6).

To "humble yourself" is to submit to God's way. It is a condition of the heart whereby one stops demanding their own way.

The Christian's submission to Christ's ruling will be revealed in loving stability as illustrated by a well-rooted tree and a well-built house (Ephesians 3:17-18).

Ephesians 3:19 And to know the love of **Christ**, which [*sur*]passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with [*unto the measure of*] all the fullness of **God**.



The WALK of the Believer CONTINUES FORWARD in faith and faithfulness through GOD'S ENABLING GRACE. God uses the faithful of other to encourage us to continue forward pursuing peace with and

ministry of other to encourage us to continue forward pursuing peace with and love for others.
