# "God's PRECEPTS for Success in the Unknown Ahead" Lessons from JOSHUA Chapter OBEDIENCE TO GOD'S WORD

Sunday, December 27, 2020

#### MAKE A QUIET COMMITMENT:

- QUIET your mind and soul before the LORD "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10)
- COMMIT to obedience: *Commit* to doing whatever God will say to you in this message *"to obey is better than sacrifice"* (1 Samuel 15:22)

**2 Timothy 2:21** If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the **Master's** use, *and* prepared unto every good work.



How will we be successful? How will we be able to faithfully follow after Him and be a useful vessel that is fit for His use?

Here in Joshua chapter 1, we see a **Biblical principle** which contains some precepts and some promises.

A precept is a command that is our responsibility to **obey**.

A promise is God's responsibility to fulfill based upon our obedience of the precept. A promise within a Biblical principle can only be enjoyed by the person who obeys the precept.

### I. Remember My Promises (Joshua 1:1-5)

Joshua 1:5 "...as I was with Moses, *so* I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee."

**Hebrews 13:5** Let your conversation [the message of your life or your way of life] be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for **He** hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

? What is God's model for success in this new year?

## Remember that success in our Christian lives is based upon our obedience to God and His Word.

Psalm 119:105 "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."

### II. Respond to My Precepts: (Joshua 1:6-8)

A. Consider the 1<sup>st</sup> Command: Be <u>Confident</u> because of the Word— "be thou strong and very courageous" (v. 6-7)

Joshua's strength and courage was to be in God. This would enable him to do the commands that followed in these verses.

B. Consider the 2<sup>nd</sup> Command: Be <u>obedient</u> to the Word—"observe to do according to all the Law" (v. 7)

**Deuteronomy 29:9** Keep therefore the words of this Covenant, and do them, that ye may <u>prosper</u> [*to act with prudence*] in all that ye do.

C. Consider the 3<sup>rd</sup> Command: Be <u>directed</u> by the Word—"turn not from it" (v. 7)

**D.** Consider the 4<sup>th</sup> Command: Be <u>vocal</u> about the Word—"this book of the Law shall not depart out of thy mouth" (v. 8)

<u>Romans 12:1</u> I beseech you therefore, brethren, by <u>the mercies of God</u>, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is* your reasonable service.

This is possible when we obey this next point.

E. Consider the 5<sup>th</sup> Command: Be <u>daily</u> in the Word—"thou shalt meditate therein day and night" (v. 8)

### III. Remember My Promise (Joshua 1:8-9)


A. Consider the 2<sup>nd</sup> Promise: Know <u>SUCCESS</u> as promised in the Word— "then thou shalt have good success" (v. 8)

The word "prosperous" describes the work of the Holy Spirit in one's life.

B. Consider the 3<sup>rd</sup> Promise: Know <u>encouragement</u> from the Word—"for the LORD thy God is with thee" (v. 9)

Notice that the Lord ends with the promise He began with—"I will be with you!"

Look at Who is commanding you! As God speaks to you He says, Who AM I? What have I done? AM I worthy to be obeyed? Do My words ring hollow because My past has been contrary to what I AM commanding you now?



God's PROMISE FOR SUCCESS in the unknown ahead are enjoyed when we OBEY THE PRECEPTS He commands. We must be diligent to remember His promises and respond to His precepts. We must be CONFIDENT because of His Word, OBEDIENT to His Word, DIRECTED by the Word, VOCAL with God's Words, and DAILY in His Word.

  - b. In what situations will I most likely be tempted <u>not</u> to respond in a Christ-like way?
  - c. How can I get ready for those situations? (*If I don't have a plan for change, it probably won't happen.*)
